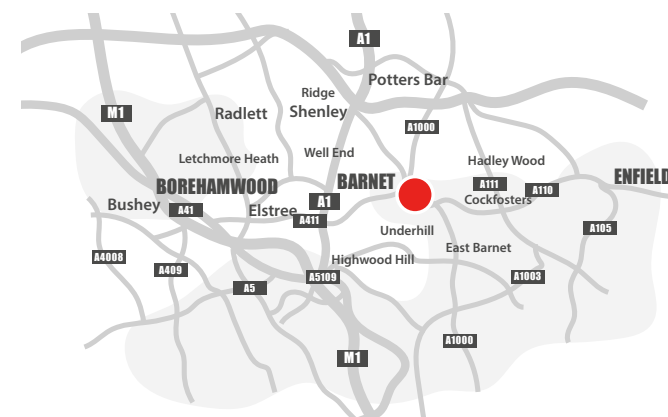
The Spires Barnet

The London Borough of Barnet is a suburban London borough in North London, England, forming part of Outer London. It is the second largest London borough by population with 331,500 inhabitants and covers an area of 33 sq miles, the fourth highest. It borders Hertfordshire to the north and five other London boroughs: Harrow and Brent to the west, Camden and Haringey to the south-east and Enfield to the east. With a population estimated at around 332,000 and 67% of householders being owner-occupiers provides a strong residential local audience. Incidentally, Barnet also has the largest Chinese population of any London borough!

The Spires Shopping Centre is the principal retail destination within the town centre and is retail anchored by Waitrose, WH Smith, New Look and Costa with Carluccio's being the main restaurant anchor.

A £10m investment will upgrade the retail mix with the addition of a two storey H&M fashion store and enhance the leisure mix with two additional restaurants. JD Sports opened in the summer 2019 and continues the centre's transformation into a prime destination for both shopping and entertainment. Key tenants include Waitrose, New Look, H&M, EE, Carphone Warehouse, Savers, Card Factory and JD Sports.

Site 1: Size 3m X 1.4m. Covered open mall, with power.

Site 2: Size 4m X 6m External. With power.

Site 3: Size 3m X 1.4m. Covered open mall, with power.

Site 4: Size 3m X 2m. No power.

Site 6: Size 2m X 1.4m. Covered open mall, with power.

Site 7: Size 1m X 1m pop-up stands only. Covered open mall, no power.
